

Thursday 1st April 2021

You should have received a letter by email this week from Halton Strategic Director Mil Vasic thanking you for your efforts in bringing down the infection rates in Halton. I would like to echo that sentiment and say thank you to all of you for continuing to follow the rules. There have been a few class closures in schools in Halton and luckily it hasn't been us.

This week has seen a start in the easing of lockdown and at the risk of sounding like a broken record, we all need to keep following the scientific advice. Children should not be meeting up with large groups and there should still be no meeting up indoors.

By the time we return (19th April) we should be able to do a bit more...

Stage two (no earlier than 12 April):

- *All shops allowed to open, along with close-contact services, including hairdressers and beauty salons*
- *Restaurants and pubs allowed to serve food and alcohol to customers sitting outdoors*
- *Gyms and spas can reopen, as can zoos, theme parks, libraries and community centres*
- *Members of the same household can take a holiday in England in self-contained accommodation*
- *Weddings attended by up to 15 people can take place*

A reminder that if anyone is symptomatic then you must use a PCR test at a local centre. They can also be ordered from the government website. The quick LFD tests are only for non-symptomatic testing. These can also be ordered from the government website. We have also ordered more of the postal tests (PCR) if you ever need any.

This table explains the requirements of notifying us over Easter. If you have any positive test results up to 3rd April, we need to alert the rest of the relevant bubble.

18 April 2021	Notify school if your child is self-isolating and will not be returning on the 19 April 2021	sec.woodside@halton.gov.uk
19 April 2021	Notify school if your child develops symptoms of COVID-19 and / or is tested positive after a PCR	Sec.woodside@halton.gov.uk Or 01928 564031
